

Confine Small Emergencies

This course covers the competency required to confine small emergencies in a facility. Small emergencies may include such incidents as a small fire that can be controlled using a nearby fire extinguisher. This course is nationally recognised.

Nationally Recognised Training

Duration and Location

This course is delivered over three hours and can be delivered at your premises or at a Chubb training facility.

When conducted on your site we require:

- Access to a room suitable for delivering a PowerPoint presentation
- External area that is a minimum 5m x 5m for practical training. This area should not be undercover, on a driveway or on a slope.

Content

- Prepare for emergency situations
- Identify and assess the emergency
- Safely confine emergencies where possible
- Use initial response equipment
- Report facility emergencies
- Use of portable firefighting equipment
- Action in responding to emergencies



Course Participation

This course is limited to a maximum of 15 participants.

Participants require the following for the course:

- Photo Identification
- Pen and paper
- Suitable clothing including long pants and enclosed footwear

Language, Literacy and Numeracy

Participants are required to understand the main ideas in documents such as safety data sheets or an emergency plan, write at least one paragraph and participate in basic oral communication to successfully complete this course.

You will be assessed with a combination of multiple choice written questions and practical activities.
